Enjoy summer art classes in a casual atmosphere - outdoors! Join us as we explore the fundamentals of art-making. Each week, students will explore a different art discipline in 2, 2 1/2 hour art classes. Students may enroll in one course or all five weeks!

2-Dimensional Art Course - Mornings

Experiment with a variety of materials, including *tempera paint, watercolors, pastels, oil pastels, charcoal, paper and more* as we learn traditional drawing, painting and printmaking techniques. Students will learn techniques specific to cultural and historical art forms as we create art inspired by a range of artists throughout history.

Illustration - As a class, we will choose a story to recreate in our own style using traditional drawing skills and exploring color use. Each student gets a copy of the class's illustrated story to share with friends and family.

Landscapes - Enjoy the wonderful world of Plein Air painting! Learn the techniques of landscape greats like Monet and VanGogh to turn your pictures- real or imaginary- into beautiful paintings.

Still Life - Learn the traditional art of the still life with fun objects students bring in or choose. We will work in realism and abstraction to learn the basics of form, composition, color and light in drawing and painting.

Portraits - Apply the fundamentals of form, shape and proportion to the face! Gain experience in drawing and painting portraits and self portraits from life and a photograph that you bring in.

Collage - Explore your own creative ideas with collage. Students will use an array of collage materials to compose pictures as unique as themselves!

3-Dimensional Art Course - Afternoons

Learn a range of exciting hands-on art forms. We will explore various materials including *clay, paper-mache, recycled materials, paper, fabric, and more*. Students will learn about different sculptural practices throughout art history and will explore the process of creation from idea to product.

Papercrafting - Create new sheets of paper from recycled ones! Learn the process, history, and beauty of hand-made paper. Students will engage in the process of papermaking, and create their own journals and papercrafts.

Pop Art - Explore the art movement of the late 50's and 60's that brought the everyday into the artworld. Use materials to create an over-sized replica of a popular product or object.

Clay - Create tiles, masks, mugs and more with clay. Learn the history of clay and use age-old techniques to create your own unique sculptures and wares. (please allow 2 weeks for drying and firing of projects)

Mask & Jewelry-making - Students will work with various materials to create a mask and jewelry such as air-dry clay, paper-mache and recycled materials.
